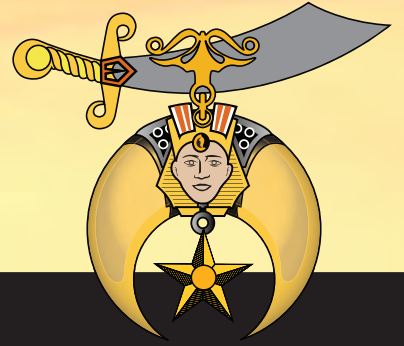

Now with the fun comes some seriousness that needs to be addressed.

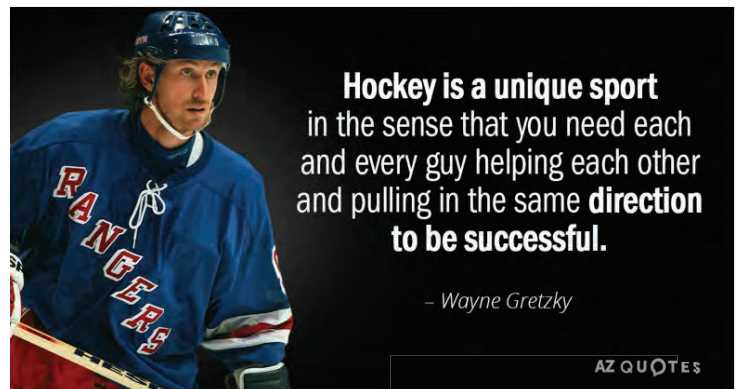

Welcome to November Nobles,

This year is going by quite quick. I know many of you were inundated with emails and notices from me about the Food Caravan over this year. No matter how much it seemed redundant, it was quite necessary. But the diligence paid off for Shriner's Children's Portland. As of October 23, 2024 we had a total of \$98,520 in cash and food donations for the Hospital.

The Burns FFA auction was great this year with 19 animals donated for a value of \$69,572 in meat. We received \$4,507.14 in non-perishable goods from Central Oregon Shrine Club and Springfield-Eugene Shrine Club. Tillamook County Shrine Club donates monthly 60lbs of cheese and Clatsop County Shrine Club facilitates 12 one- gallon bags of Clam Chowder concentrate (makes 60 gallons) every 3 months. The remaining was cash donations from Hillah Shriners, Affi Shriners, Columbia County Shrine Club, Legion of Honor – Hap Baldwin Platoon, Shurtah First Responders

Club, Desert Patrol, Desert Shrine Club, and Oriental Band donated all the proceeds from the Western Night and facilitated the transport of the meat from the butcher to Hospital.

I would like to thank all those who helped with the Food Caravan this year. I would also like to thank the Masonic Youth Groups of DeMolay, Job's Daughters and Rainbow Girls for coming out to help with the wrapping of pallets of food; Noble John Wahl and Lady Barbara for coming in the night before to set up the tables for the Western Night.

We have seen a growth in the Food Caravan since Covid and lets make 2025 even better.

HOSPITAL SNACK CLOSET

Fellow Nobles,

Over the years I have had the fortune to meet numerous fellow Al Kader Shriners throughout the State. All these men are exceptional fellows and very supportive of Shrine and its philanthropies. Unfortunately, many Nobles have felt a disconnect with Al Kader Temple and most importantly Shriners Hospital Children's Portland. The reasons are many, but the point is we are all Al Kader Shriners which supports the hospital in Portland.

If you may not be aware our hospital has been chosen to provide services to needed children worldwide. We have the greatest doctors and excellent facilities including places for these international patients to reside during their often-long-term care.

Unfortunately, these families, especially the kiddos, cannot access one of the most important components of their lives-SNACKS. Most of us have been around children and understand the need for this vital component in their lives. Our hospital has a dining room, but it closes at the end of dinner, and they are too far to buy snacks to help them through those long evenings and downtime.

It has been proposed that Al Kader Shriners set up a "Snack Closet" where non-perishable snacks could be available to them and their families during their long stay at our hospital.

To maintain this "Snack Closet" we need, at the minimum, two clubs or units to provide a minimum of \$50/month to help keep it stocked. I hope some of our smaller units or clubs will take up this cause. First to help our kiddos, and secondly provide a direct link to your hospital.
