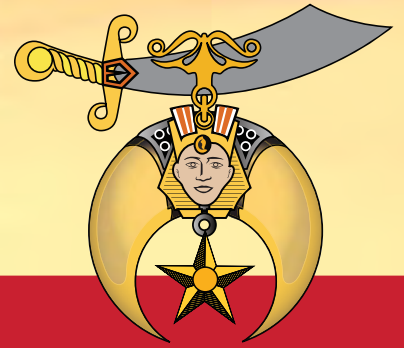

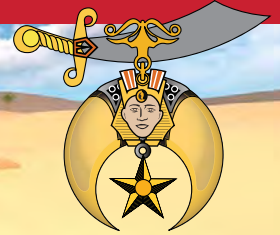

COME ALIVE IN 2025...

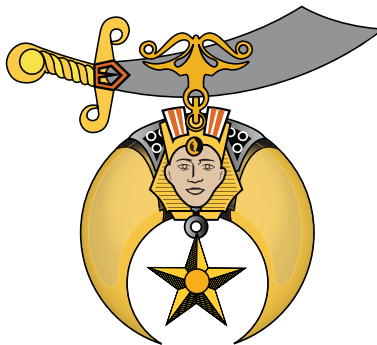
Nobles and Ladies

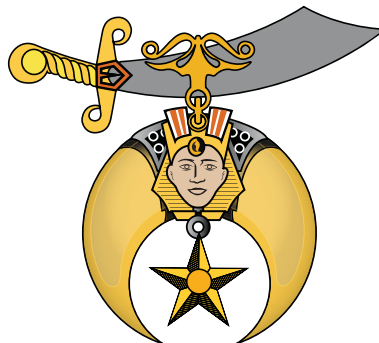

Brother Nobles

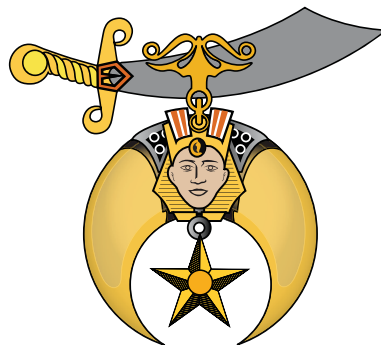

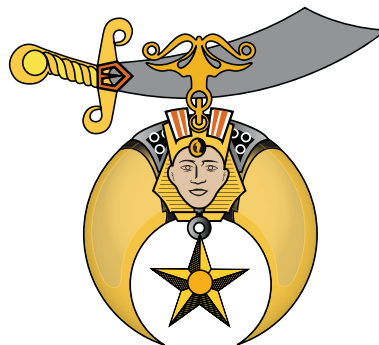
COME ALIVE IN 2025...
