

The brace extended up above my ankle, there is nobody in my family that can verify my memory, so maybe I was almost a "Shriner Child." This childhood memory left a lasting impression that would be rekindled years later.

I have been given several different answers to the question of "Why did you become a Mason/Shriner?" Some of these reasons are: to become a better man, for the social aspect, for the brotherhood and community, and to have a sense of belonging. Another reason that I have heard on more than one occasion is "to belong to something that is bigger than I am." As usual there were numerous legislative Amendments and resolutions to vote on that will affect the Nobles everywhere. Here are some of the highlights:

- Art 5 mileage and per diem was to reduce the reimbursement of delegates to Imperial Sessions over a three year period and then be totally gone : Defeated
- Art 11 raise the annual per capita from \$50 to \$70: Defeated
- Art 23 Temple Membership suspension for NPD procedure: Passed
- Art 30 Discipline by Temple procedures updated: Defeated
- Art 31 Temple Bylaws clean up of procedure: Passed

Several articles were introduced about jurisdictional issues between Temples: All Defeated The Resolutions introduced dealt with joining Shrine Associations and changes of addresses: All Passed

All in all it was a very busy Session but your representatives were present for each and every session and dealt with each legislative item that was introduced.

Finally, the Marketing and Communications Department introduced the newest campaign that will begin to air on media markets across the US and other countries. It is called "Brotherhood for a New Generation" and is intended to reach out to the younger generations to inspire them to join out Fraternity. As a side note I am requesting that each and every Noble look around and find a brother Mason who you feel would experience the fulfilling excitement of being a Noble of the Mystic Shrine.
