

We need to UP OUR GAME in the fundraising area if we are to keep our building. Fundraising is the responsibility of every member of Al Kader.

In 2026 we will have three fundraising events; PDX0tica, the Tiki bar event, the Music Festival and a sportsman's raffle. The raffle is an idea that I borrowed from my brother's temple in Mississippi. With only 300+ members they net over \$60,000 each year. I think we can match that. And, each club and unit will share in the profits. I will provide all the details at the Stated Meeting this month.

The key to successful fundraising is participation of the members. We all need to look for ways to support our fundraising events. We have also appointed a few members to focus on getting local sponsorships for our fundraising events. Together, we can get out financial picture back on track for a long future.

I want to close on a different note, our hospital. Shriner Childrens Portland has opened its third clinic. On November 20th, we had the ribbon cutting at our new Vancouver clinic. In addition to Vancouver, we also have clinics in Medford and Redmond. The Vancouver clinic is a project that has been in the works for several years and will help us achieve our mission of "more kids in the right places." Unlike the other clinics that are only opened a few days each week, the Vancouver clinic will be open 5 days a week. This will help us expand out Sports Injury program.

These clinics allow our kids to receive treatment closer to home. They also provide more visibility for our hospital system. At a time when many hospital systems are cutting back, Shriners Childrens continues to grow.






PUMPAN CARMING

Membership Reminder

Nobles and Ladies,

The membership of Al Kader Shrine is critical to our Temple and Shriners Children's. I am positive that each and everyone of you know this! Without our Temple family, which includes all of the Nobility, their ladies, their children we would not be complete!

As your Potentate I am required to send notification to each Noble who is in jeopardy of having their membership suspended, because they are delinquent in paying their dues. We send these notification letters to those who are two years past due. This is not a task that I have enjoyed, in fact I really wish that it did not have to be done!

Unfortunately, as you read this article several of these notification letters have been sent to those Nobles affected. Unfortunately, we have not been able to contact everyone. Compounding the challenge of contacting everyone is that some of the phone numbers, we have been not correct or the mailbox is full and a message cannot be left. Even when we do leave messages, the individuals do not respond.

I would like to thank Asst. Rabban Blair Hill and Noble Danny Adamson as well as the other Nobles who have made phone calls, sent emails and worked diligently to contact the Nobility.

During this process I have asked myself, WHY are the Nobility not paying their Shrine Dues? Is it because they simple forget, I don't think so. Each Noble receives two written notifications from Imperial. Is there a problem with understanding the Dues Process?

Let's look at the situation, break it down together! Membership dues have three separate components.

#1. Al Kader Temple Dues \$105.00 per year #2. Per Capita Assessment by Imperial \$50.00 per year #3. Per Capita Hospital Assessment \$5.00 per year

Total Dues Per Year \$160.00

I can understand where a Noble may think that he purchased a "Life Membership" and as a result his dues is paid for his lifetime. A Temple Life Membership does not eliminate the other yearly dues. Yes, Al Kader has a "Life Membership" available, we even have a plan where you can make monthly payments. If you are interested simply contact IS Ron Gamble, our recorder.

As of this writing there are over ninety Nobles who are delinquent in their dues. Some of these amounts are as small as ten dollars! Other amounts are significant enough that the Nobles will be suspended at the end of December 2025. If you do not know the status of your dues account, simply contact the recorder. I know that several Nobles have been contacted and have paid their amount owed and I thank you! In conclusion, if every Noble paid their dues and each year, Al Kader would be in a better financial position!
