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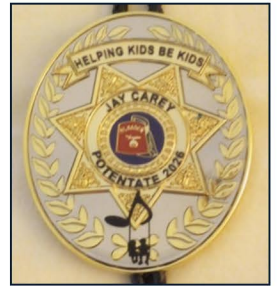

The year is off to a good start. I.S. Jay's installation was a hit. It was wonderfully attended and it was great to see the Divan from Hillah come up and support.

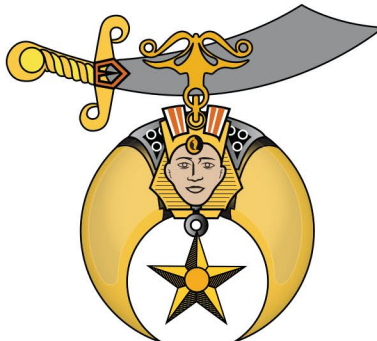

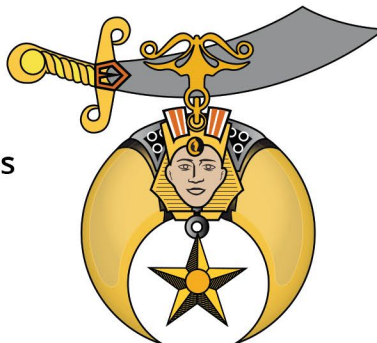

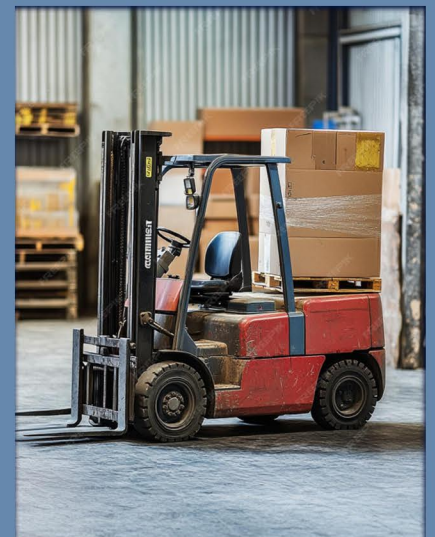

The list is updated frequently and is available for anyone to refer to and purchase.

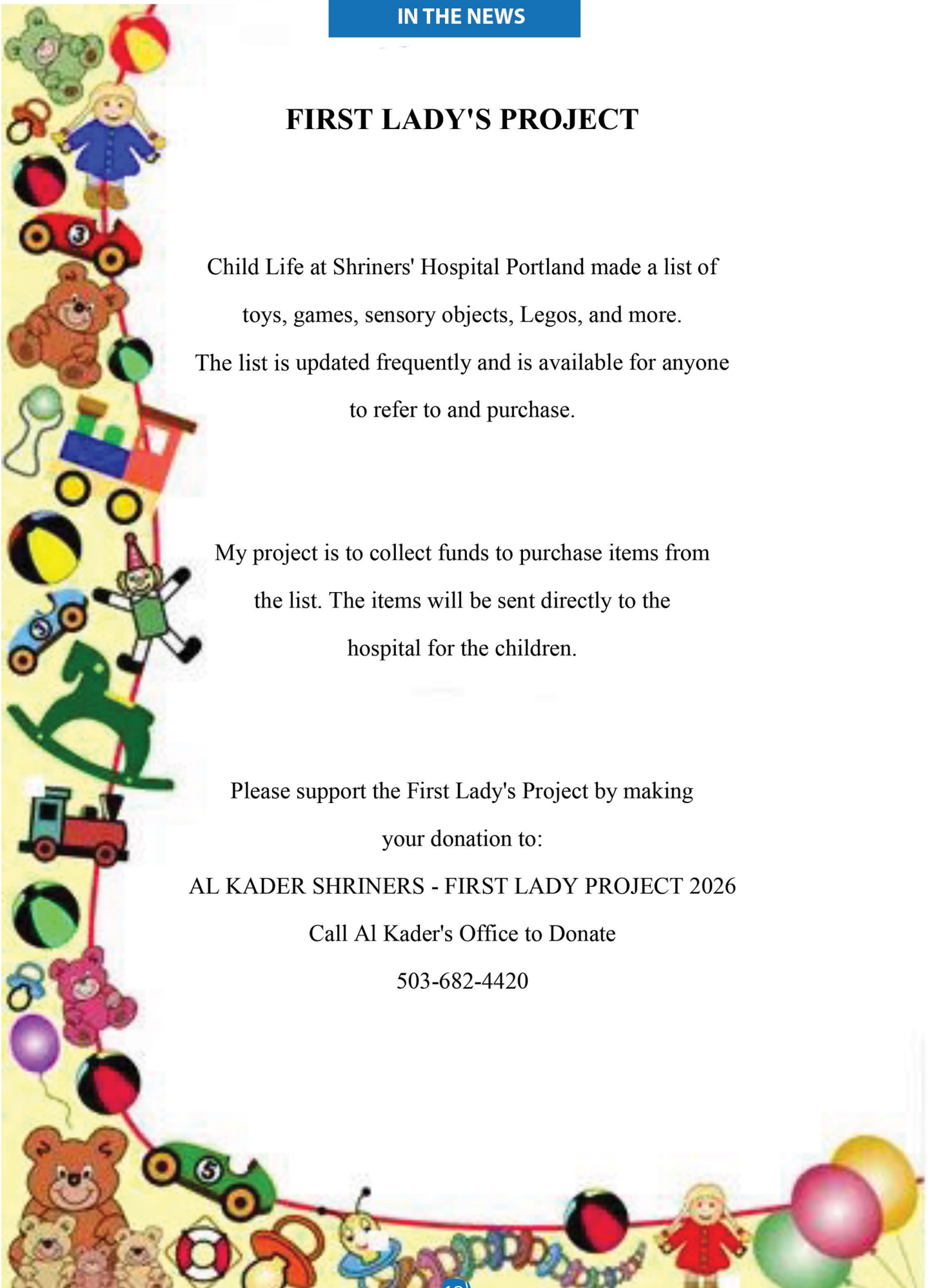
My project is to collect funds to purchase items from the list. The items will be sent directly to the hospital for the children.

DR. SEUSS ISN'T LOOSE – Chapter 2a

To paraphrase Dr. Seuss:

"My names not Bauxman or Bisby or Bray
or Mordecai Ali Van Allen O'Shea,
I'm not off to great places
I'm not on my way!"

My name is Champoeg Masonic Lodge and I am not on my way to anywhere. I have been stuck in this same place for over 100 years.

Most of my history lies not in dates and places but in what I have done for others. I went to those same great places watching the movies when Canby's first movie theatre was here and in books when the Public Library was here. I have been home to many of Canby's historic businesses: a pool hall, cigar store, drug store, doctor, variety stores, candy store, music store, and more. I almost was the Post Office and the newspaper office. Upstairs has been an apartment, library, office and more.

I welcomed vets home when America's wars ended, clapped when parades went by, and watched generations grow up. I laughed when the first car rumbled past me, I kept time by the chugs of steam trains and stood through earthquakes and storms. I'm full of over 100 years of great things but I have not traveled 1 foot.

It took over 2 years to plan and build me. The man who built me said I would only cost about \$8,800 (over \$200,000 today). I turned out to cost over \$15,000 (over \$400,000 today). They built me strong enough to hold up 2 wooden buildings.

For many years I was the tallest building in town. At one time, I was dwarfed only by the old volunteer fire tower in downtown Canby.

From afar, I still look the same as I did over 100 years ago. Close-up you can tell I've had numerous "nose jobs," paint jobs and face lifts. I've had at least three different front entrances. About every 10 years I have my roof repaired. I was called "the cats pajamas" when I was young, but today people drive right by me and say nothing.

Masonic meetings were held in me, by candlelight, until 1920 when I got wired for electricity. For my 21st birthday, I received new benches for my dining room, a new paint job and new linoleum upstairs. My 43rd was celebrated with another new paint job. In 1967 my front-room Lodge Room was remodeled. I have been called "warm" and "inviting".

My memory loss issues tend to rise with age. I think I recall that recently I received a new entrance, new stairs, new paint, new windows and {pause} a new elevator. I now have a newer basement, lobby and front windows. My lobby and face have been repainted. I am so awesome!

Sometimes, standing in one place for over 100 years isn't so bad. Oh, I am so special. I have seen so many great things.

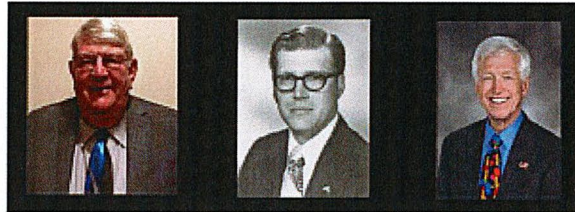
