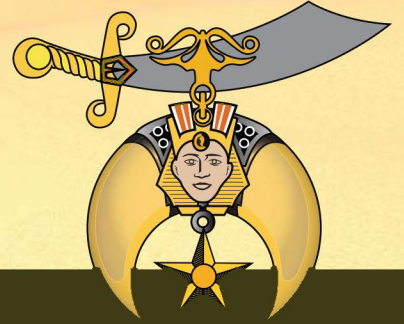

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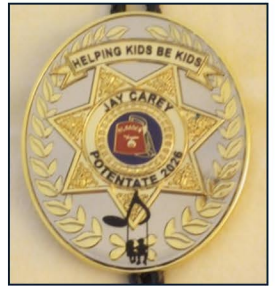

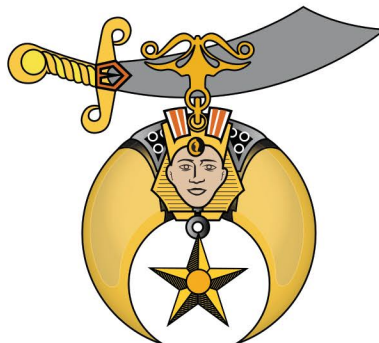

Potentate's notes

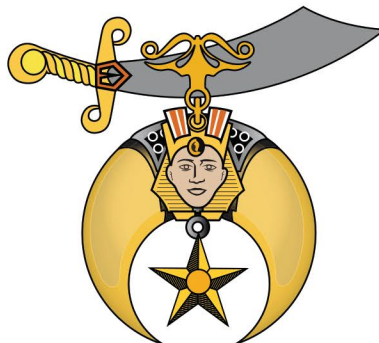

September is here, and boy has this year been moving fast. The Summer was filled with so many activities that it has been one big blur.

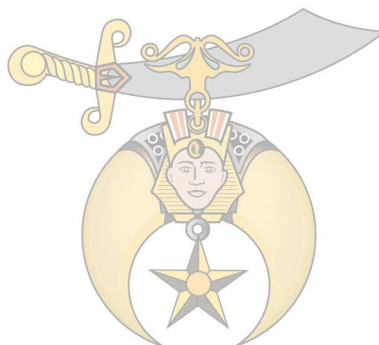

Dues must be paid online via Webfez or by Check to Al Kader's office. The office will no longer accept credit card payments for dues to reduce card processing fees.

Step 1: Log into Webfez.

Step 2: At top of page you will see your balance for your dues owed.

Click the Button "Pay my Bill."

The system will give you a pop up letting you know that you are being redirected to the pay portal. Click Continue.

Step 3: Enter your payment information. and click "Submit Payment"

The list is updated frequently and is available for anyone to refer to and purchase.

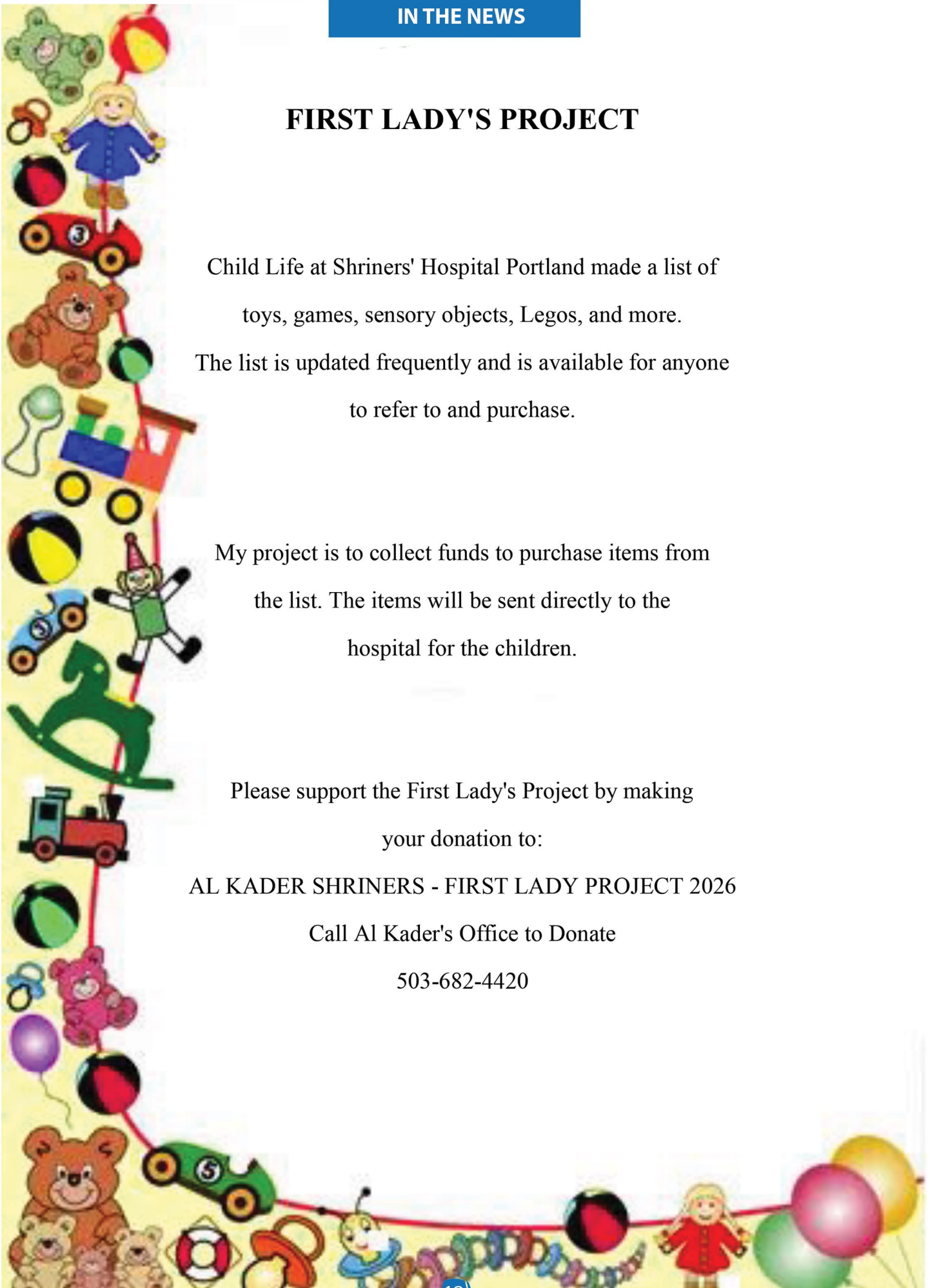

Every year, Shriners, football players, friends and family descend upon Baker City, Oregon for the Oregon Shriners East-West All-Star Football game. This year marked our 75th game, and it did not disappoint. Players arrived in La Grande at Eastern Oregon University the Sunday before the game. After checking in, they congregate at Zabel Hall where they receive their jerseys and meet their coaches. They also learn about what they are playing for. This year, Chelsea Thompson (East Queen from 2025) came and spoke to the Players about how Shriners Children's changed her life. During the practice week, the players spend hours learning to work together on and off the field. They are treated to BBQs, social events and more to encourage teamwork and comradery.

Starting on Wednesday and Thursday before the game, Shriners from Al Kader, Hillah arrive and settle in for a few days of fun and relaxation. Nobles from El Korah and Afifi are to be found there as well. The Al Kader Caravanners club puts on a chuckwagon breakfast on Friday which is followed by a lunch at the Elks Lodge honoring the Queens and Co-Captains, where they are introduced to the Nobles and families, we hear their stories and they receive they Jerseys, Sashes, Crowns and ballcaps.
